Scholarship Application Success for Women in Career Tech Bevill State Community College Walker County/Jefferson County Residents

In Partnership with the Women's Fund of Greater Birmingham

Eligible recipients must be female head of households living at 200% poverty or greater, living in Walker or Jefferson Counties. Scholarships used for tuition, books, tools, and supplies for Career Technical Education where women are an underrepresented population. If other funding such as Pell grant or Workforce Investment Opportunity Act covers these expenses, scholarship money may go to assist with necessary living expenses (food, housing, transportation, etc.) to reduce the barriers to college attendance.

Bevill State Admissions and FAFSA must be complete and submitted in order for consideration of scholarship.

Scholarship is for three semesters and dependent upon maintaining a 2.0 GPA each semester. Amounts are as follows:

- 1st Semester: \$1,550.00
- 2nd Semester: \$1,500.00
- 3rd Semester: \$1,500.00

At the end of each semester, scholarship recipients are eligible for monetary incentives based on GPA:

- \$100.00 for maintaining a 2.00-2.99 Semester GPA
- \$150.00 for maintaining a 3.00-3.99 Semester GPA
- \$200.00 for maintaining a 4.00 Semester GPA

Scholarship recipients will be required to meet with Bevill State's Thrive Together Success Coach as needed, but at a minimum of once every semester. The Success Coach will provide support, connections to tutoring when needed, and make referrals to community services.
