APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

1. Complete a Bevill State Application for Admission and submit it to the Office of Student Services. *Applicants for Health Science programs must complete an additional program application form available in the Office of Student Services.*
2. Submit an official copy of GED certificate or high school transcript or college transcript(s) to the campus where classes will be taken. Transcripts must be on file prior to admission or during the first term of enrollment.
3. Students who have graduated from a non-accredited high school or received an Alabama Occupational Diploma must score 16 on the ACT or equivalent score on the SAT, or successfully pass the GED exam.
4. Contact the Office of Student Services to schedule an appointment to take the COMPASS placement test. Students who can provide documentation of ACT subtest scores of 20 in Math and 20 in English on the same score report and are enrolling in BSCC within three years of high school graduation should contact the campus testing coordinator to review placement.
5. Transfer students must submit official copies of all college transcripts.
6. Transient students must submit an authorized Transient Student Form from the degree-granting institution.
7. **Accelerated** high school students must have an overall “B” average, be in grade 11 or 12 and submit a Special Admissions Approval Form authorized by the high school principal or counselor prior to enrollment. **Dual** enrollment/dual credit applicants must have an overall “B” average as earned in standard, regulation high school courses, normally leading to the high school diploma, be enrolled in grade 10, 11, or 12, and must have written approval of the Principal, local Superintendent of Education, and the President of Bevill State Community College prior to enrollment. Six semester credit hours at the post-secondary level shall equal one credit at the high school level in the same or a related subject. The applicant must meet the entrance requirements established by Bevill State. The **Early College Enrollment Program (ECEP)** allows high school students to work toward a technical college degree or certificate while completing their high school graduation requirements. To enroll, students must complete college admission requirements and receive approval from their counselor, principal and superintendent to enroll in ECEP. In addition, students must have at least a 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale, pass the high school exit exam before the 12th grade, and take the COMPASS test with placement in MTH 100 and ENG 101. Once accepted, students must enroll as a full-time student at Bevill State with at least 12 hours each semester and maintain a 2.0 GPA.
8. Students wishing to apply for admission under the provision of the State Plan for Exceptional Children and Youth must contact the Office of Student Services for additional information.
9. Some programs require a minimum ACT score to be on file prior to consideration for admission. Contact the Office of Student Services for specific program requirements.

ATTENTION APPLICANT:

Effective spring semester 2009, Alabama State Board of Education policy 801.01, Admissions General, requires that applicants to Alabama Community College System institutions provide one primary form of documentation OR two secondary forms of documentation prior to admission.

Primary or secondary forms of documentation must be presented in person or a notarized copy sent via U.S. mail to the Office of Student Services. Faxed copies will NOT be accepted. Applicants are not admitted to Bevill State Community College until one primary or two secondary forms of documentation are provided.

Prior to being admitted, you must present one primary form of documentation from the list below:

- Unexpired Alabama driver's license or instruction permit
- Unexpired Alabama identification card
- Unexpired U.S. passport
- Unexpired U.S. permanent resident card
- Resident Alien card prior to 1997
- U.S. Alien Registration Receipt card (Form I-151) prior to 1978
- BIA or Tribal identification card with photo

If an applicant cannot present primary documentation, applicant must provide two secondary forms of documentation, one of which must be a photo identification card, such as a school ID (with photo) or an employee ID (with photo), and one additional item from the list below:

- BIA or tribal affidavit of birth or certificate of Indian blood
- Certified copy of a U.S. Birth Certificate or a U.S. State Department Certificate of Birth Abroad
- Concealed Weapons Permit
- Social Security Card (w/o restrictions)
- U.S. application for voluntary departure under family unity program (Form I-797)
- U.S. Armed Forces Driver's License
- U.S. Certificate of Citizenship
- U.S. Certificate of Naturalization
- U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs Card
- U.S. Military DD-214
- U.S. Military I.D. (active duty, reserve, retired)
- U.S. notice of approval to apply for permanent residents (Form I-171 or I-463)
- U.S. Temporary Resident card (Form I-688)
- U.S. travel document (mint green cover) endorsed with Permit to reenter (Form I327 or refugee travel document Form I-571)
- USCIS employment authorization document (I-688A, I-688B, I-766)
- USCIS I94 or I94A form
- Other documentation issued by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services or presenting status permitted under 8 U.S. Code section 1621 and 1641

All **male** students between the ages of 18-26 must register with the United States Military Selective Service prior to admission to the College. If you have not done so, please register at www.sss.gov.
