

**Bevill State Community College  
Disbursement Procedures  
Pell Grant Program  
2009-2010**

The following procedures are outlined so that you will be aware of the time of check disbursement, governing policies, and approved procedures that will be adhered to by the Financial Aid Office.

Students who have established Pell Grant eligibility (submitted valid Student Aid Report and all required documentation ten days prior to registration), have registered, and are attending class will receive the balance of their Pell Award on the fourteenth day of classes each semester. By signing this agreement, tuition, fees, and dorm rent for on-campus housing (if applicable) may be deducted from your Pell Grant award prior to and during registration and late registration. Also, by signing this agreement books and tools may be charged to your Pell Grant award **only after you have attended at least one class session for each registered class.**

On the fourteenth day of classes, a check for the remaining balance of your Pell Grant award will be issued. Times and locations for check disbursement will be announced. You must show your student I.D. to obtain your check.

Students who establish their Pell Grant eligibility (submit a valid Student Aid Report and all required documentation) after the beginning of the semester will receive the balance his or her eligible Pell award on established designated days to be determined in agreement with the Business Office. These dates will be published at the beginning of each semester in the Office of Student Services.

**IMPORTANT: If you completely withdraw from the college before the 60% point of the semester, you may owe a repayment to the Pell Grant Program. Students who owe repayments will not be allowed to use any Title IV financial assistance at this institution or any other institution until the payment is made.**

**Also, reducing your enrollment status or withdrawing from the college may affect the required standards of progress and cause you to lose your eligibility to receive financial assistance. Standards of Progress for financial assistance eligibility are published in the college catalog, the student handbook, and the Financial Aid brochure.**

By signing the application, you agree, if asked, to provide information that will verify the accuracy of your completed file. This information may include a copy of your U.S. or state income tax form Also, you certify that you (1) will use federal student aid only to pay the cost of attending an institution of higher education, (2) are not in default on a federal student loan or have made satisfactory arrangements to repay it, (3) do not owe money back on a federal student grant or have made satisfactory arrangements to repay it, and (4) will notify your school if you default on a federal student loan. If you purposely give false or misleading information, you may be fined \$20,000, sent to prison, or both.

**NOTICE: You CAN NOT receive a Pell Grant if you have received a Bachelor's Degree or higher educational degree.**
