POLITICAL ACTIVITY

All personnel are encouraged to participate actively and freely as citizens in their community. However, no employee may use his or her position or scheduled work hours for political purposes. Prior to seeking election or appointment to a political office, an employee must give notice to the appropriate administrator and to the President.

Sections 36-12-60, et seq., of the Code of Alabama (1975) makes it illegal for “any officer or employer of the State of Alabama to use or permit to be used any state-owned property of any character or description, including stationery, stamps, office equipment, office supplies, automobiles or any other property used by his or her, in his or her custody, or under his or her control, for the promotion or advancement of the interest of any candidate for public office of the state of Alabama.”
