How do we calculate a full-time equivalent student (FTE)?

There are two common formulae used in the calculation of an FTE.

FTE Definition 1:

The sum of undergraduate student credit hours divided by 15.

Example: Undergraduate SCH
 $42,000 \div 15 = 2,800$

FTE Definition 2 (IPEDS FTE):

Used for mandatory federal reporting (i.e., IPEDS) and publications ranging from Baron's to U.S. News. The full-time headcount plus 1/3 of part-time headcount.

Example:
Full-time HC = 2,250
Part-time HC/3 (3000/3) = 1,000
Total FTE (2,250 + 1,000) = 3,250
