HyFlex courses feature highly flexible course delivery methods that offer students multiple options for receiving instruction and participating in course activities. These may include a mix of face-to-face, online, or virtual instruction. Available options may vary by course, see detailed course note under course description when searching for classes to see information on which methods above the course will utilize.

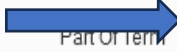
